Dominique Jones is a power guard. He is a terrific driver that has a knack at getting to the free throw line. He attempted 282 free throws in 33 games last season. Jones is fantastic around the rim with the ability to finish plays through traffic. He is a good ball handler and has the ability to run a team. He only averaged 3.6 ast/game, but that may be connected to the lack of talent around him at South Florida. Jones is a very good rebounder. He is not afraid to be physical. Jones is the true definition of a combo guard. He can also play seemingly unlimited minutes.

The question that will always haunt Jones is if he can shoot consistently enough from the perimeter. If he cannot, defenders will simply play him for the drive and he will struggle against NBA defenders because he is an average athlete and has average quickness. He never made better than 35 percent from 3-point territory in his career. If Jones can become a consistent shooter, he has a chance to be one of the biggest steals in this draft. Additionally, the lack of quickness and average athleticism has led to defensive struggles at South Florida for Jones.
