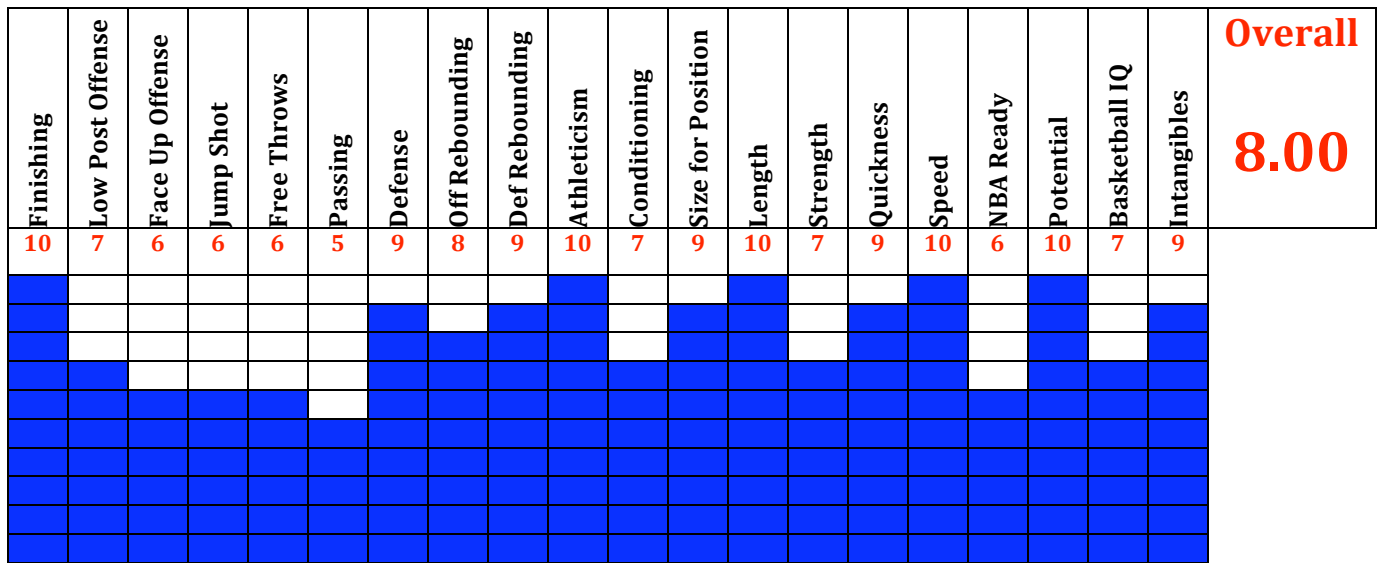

Derrick Favors is probably the most talented big man in this draft. He is the most athletic big man in this class. Favors will be able to jump with the best of them and he runs the floor extremely well. He has a chance to flourish in a fast tempo offense. Favors' strength is his defense. He is a solid individual defender and a very good help side defender. He defends pick-and-rolls well for someone his age. Favors has a 7'4" wingspan so he will be able to alter many shots in the NBA. He routinely rebounds balls outside his area. Favors is probably too unselfish. He is a very high character individual but needs to demand and shoot the ball more. He only had eight games where he attempted at least ten shots at Georgia Tech.

However, Derrick Favors is very raw and unpolished offensively. He will primarily be a dunker initially but has the athleticism and quickness to develop good footwork. He does not have much of a face up game yet, but once again, his quickness should enable him to develop a solid face up game. His jump shot needs a lot of work at this point. He is prone to turnovers on offense. Favors' main weakness defensively is he is foul prone. For such a big reputation coming into college, Favors may have underachieved from a statistical basis. As stated before, he needs to demand the ball more.
