Miroslav Raduljica passes what you would call the “eye test” for centers. He has the size, length and hands to play the position. Despite that he is not an explosive athlete, he is still a decent enough one with okay lateral quickness to play in the NBA. He will have a tough time guarding perimeter-oriented centers, but Raduljica provides many other positive traits. Offensively, he has very good footwork and post skills. He is one of few big men in this draft that possesses counter moves. He is not a great shooter and is inconsistent facing up, but he shot nearly 80 percent from the free throw line so he should not have a problem developing a consistent mid range game. Raduljica is a terrific passer. He is excellent at passing out of the double team, but can also make the spectacular pass with ease.

There are a few areas of concern. First off, Raduljica is not a good defender. He has poor fundamentals, positioning and shows a lack of interest on that end. He is just an average rebounder as well. There are also developing red flags since he decided not to participate in a June 6 workout in front of NBA scouts. He said it was because he was tired from a game played the night prior, but after that, some scouts are questioning if he will even get drafted.
