Physically, Dexter Pittman is a beast. He stands 6'11.5" with a 7'6" wingspan. He is very strong with an excellent frame. Another thing that jumps out at you with Dexter Pittman is his efficiency. He averaged 1.66 points-per-shot last year and made 65 percent of his field goal attempts. Pittman is terrific around the rim and has good post skills. He is an excellent offensive rebounder. His significant weight loss has been made famous so he will definitely do the things necessary to become a better player.

His weight is still a concern however. During the pre-draft measurements, Pittman was recorded as having 20.8 percent body fat. Though he has slimmed down considerably and consistently, his conditioning needs to improve. He did not even average 20 minutes a game last year. Pittman will never be a player that plays outside the paint. He really has no face up or jump shot game to speak of. He will need to get better from the free throw line since he will get fouled routinely. If he improves his conditioning, he can be an impact player. Few players have his size and can move like Pittman does.
